From an email:

"At about 9,000ft on the northern <u>aspect</u> of Overlook mtn we dug a pit to the ground (90cm) and got ECTX and very stable results. We found the basal faucets to be quite rounded except for some large ones growing off rocks. About 500ft higher we found a pervasive <u>wind slab</u> that stretched across the face. We got some large shooting cracks while skinning and ended up turning around. Picture is attached. Before the wind picked up we found <u>surface hoar</u> almost 3/4 of an inch deep!
