Performed <u>Stability test</u> on shoulder of Mount Fox NE facing slope at 10,300'. HS 180cm. ECTP2 40cm down on Buried <u>Surface Hoar</u>. ECTP 23 90cm down on MFcr with 1-2mm Facets. Saw several recent <u>wind slab</u> avalanches in steeper windloaded terrrain around Goose Lake, but limited activity was seen on Henderson. Lots of co/cr while touring on Mount Fox. D2 avalanche on east facing Mount Fox that appears to be on the SH layer, triggered by a <u>cornice</u> drop."
